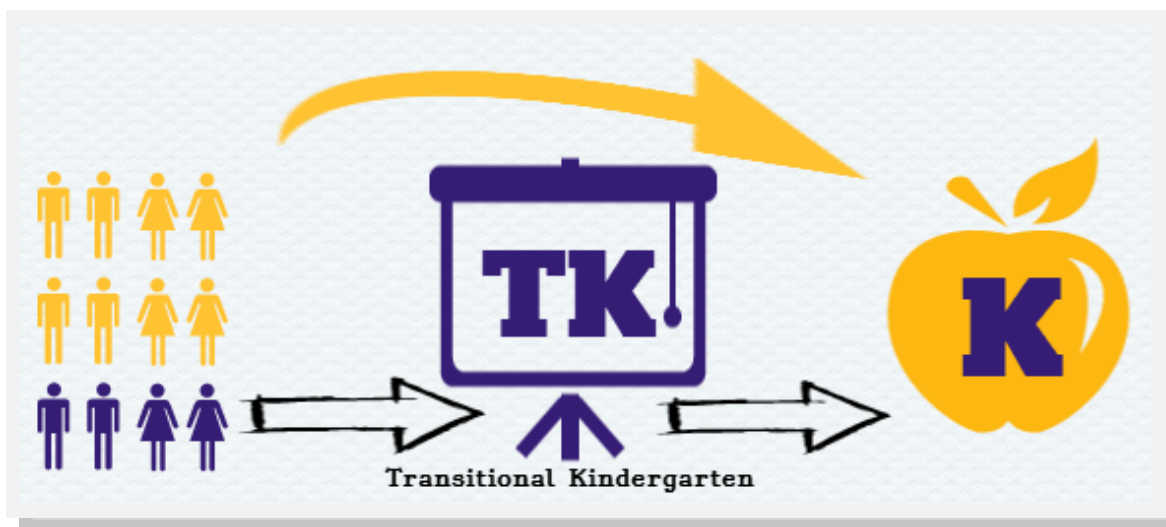

Transitional Kindergarten

Frequently Asked Questions

Is Transitional Kindergarten for students who have birthdays late in the year?

Not necessarily, though that is one reason parents may choose to enroll their child in TK. Parents may request TK, our Preschool faculty may suggest it, and our administrators may suggest this placement during the Admissions process.

Do we pay preschool or K-8 tuition for TK students?

TK students will be under the K-8 tuition schedule (available on our website) and are eligible for the Multi-Student discount, as applicable. After School Care will be available at the standard K-12 rate of \$4.00 per hour.

What will a typical day look like in Transitional Kindergarten?

TK students will wear uniforms like all K-8 students. They will be in a classroom setting just like Kindergarten but will have more hands on learning experiences. Individualized instruction is one of the main benefits of Transitional Kindergarten, and our TK teacher is very strong in this area.
