

Guidelines for use

- Use of personal devices during the school day is at the discretion of teachers and staff. Students must use devices as directed by their teacher.
- The primary purpose of the use of personal devices at school is educational.
- The use of a personal device is not to be a distraction in any way to teachers or students.
- The use of personal devices falls under The Frankfort Christian Academy Acceptable Use Policy, signed by you and your parents/guardians before using any technology devices.
- Students shall make no attempts to circumvent the school's network security and/or filtering policies. This includes setting up proxies and downloading programs to bypass security.
- Students shall not distribute pictures or video of students or staff without their permission (distribution can be as small as emailing/texting to one other person or as large as posting image or video online).
- High School students may only use the school issued device and will no longer participate in TFCA's BYOD policy. Therefore all personal devices, **including phones**, must remain locked in student lockers and will not be permitted in classrooms.

Consequences for Misuse/Disruption

(One or more may apply):

- Device taken away for the period
- Device taken away and kept in the front office until parent picks it up
- Student is not allowed to use personal devices at school
- Disciplinary Referral resulting in ISS or OSS - See AUP

School Liability Statement

Students bring their devices to use at TFCA at their own risk. It is their duty to be responsible in the upkeep and protection of their devices.

The Frankfort Christian Academy is in no way responsible for:

- Personal devices that are broken while at school or during school-sponsored activities
- Personal devices that are lost or stolen at school or during school-sponsored activities
- Maintenance or upkeep of any device (keeping it charged, installing updates or upgrades, fixing any software or hardware issues)
