PURPOSE

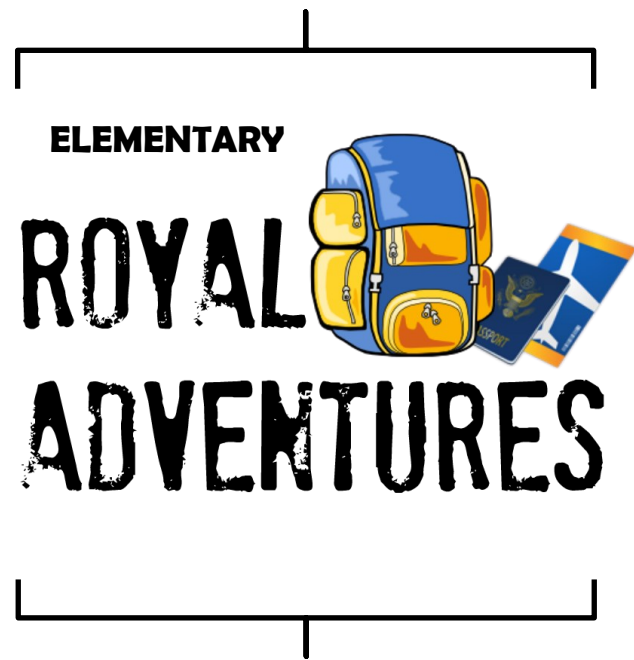
Our purpose is to educate and equip students to discover and develop to their full potential in Christ. (Psalm 139:1-4)

Fee Information

For ELEMENTARY students

- Enrollment Fee—\$50.00
- Full Time—\$135.00/week
- Drop In—\$40.00/day
- Selected Weeks (Up to 3 weeks) - \$150.00/week (MUST be paid in advance to guarantee a spot)
- If enrolled full time, payments will be automatically deducted bi-monthly, and will not be prorated for any day that a child does not attend.
- Full time students will be charged for the entire summer program, whether they attend or not. Families may choose one “vacation” week where they are not obligated to pay.
