## Parent Teacher Fellowship

### **What is PTF?**

PTF Mission Statement:

The Frankfort Christian Academy Parent-Teacher Fellowship (PTF) partners in faith with the school to help accomplish the school's mission and to support our faculty, staff and students.

At The Frankfort Christian Academy, all parents, grandparents, staff, and alumni are considered members of PTF. We strive to build partnerships to support each other through faith and service to the TFCA community.

### **What does PTF do?**

Classroom representatives

PTF Social Chairs facilitate class reps who attend PTF meetings and organize the families in their child's classroom to contribute to staff appreciation luncheons, fundraisers and the Spring Carnival.

### **Teacher Requests**

At the beginning of each semester, faculty and staff are encouraged to submit a request for PTF funds for purchase of supplies and equipment.

In prior years, the PTF has been able to provide items such as art drying racks, Bibles, books, Elementary Academic Team buzzers, registration fees for teachers to attend Workshops/Conferences/Seminars, the workroom with laminating film, bulletin board paper and inexpensive necessities (paper clips, rubber bands, etc.), a depressible book cart for the Library to use in the book drop to prevent wear and tear on books being returned, electric pencil sharpeners for some classrooms, running tokens for students awarded for miles ran and special tokens for top runners in each class, rugs for classrooms of younger students, a color ink cartridge for a classroom printer and binders to safely store literacy curriculum for middle school, Otterbox for classroom iPad, etc.

### **Spring Carnival**

April 13 or 27, 2019, PTF will host the 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Spring Carnival! Students, families, faculty and staff so enjoy this event as a school wide time of food, fun and fellowship.

### **Faculty and Staff Appreciation**

Every month, PTF organizes a luncheon for faculty and staff. The TFCA Board is provided with desserts and treats at their December meeting. Each May, meals and gifts are provided to faculty and staff to celebrate Teacher Appreciation week.

### **Honoring Graduates**

Upon graduation, PTF presents every senior with a bible and funds are used to frame a portrait of the graduating senior class.

### **How does PTF get funds?**

Box Tops

Throughout the year, families are encouraged to collect the Box Tops from participating brands and submit them to their homeroom teacher or into a receptacle. The school then gets two payments from Box Tops. One goes to the school and the other to PTF.

PTF Fundraisers

PTF strives to have one fundraiser per semester. Past fundraisers include everything from magazine subscription sales to frozen cookie dough to coupon books to family nights at area restaurants, family photography sessions and the Capital City Golf Classic tournament.

### **How can I get involved?**

PTF meets the second Tuesday of every month. The next meeting is Tuesday, September 11 at 11:30 am, in the school library.
